1. Reference is made to Headquarters' letter 15 October, 1948, file OSU 020-601 which authorized the Commander, 13th Coast Guard District to establish subject station in a caretaker status upon completion of the buildings. Headquarters is advised that the station was accepted as of 1 November, 1948, when dwellings became livable, and four men reported that date as caretakers.

2. The acceptance of the station was subject to the provision that unaccomplished items be completed as materials became available.

3. It is therefore recommended that OFFAC be amended as follows:
