- 1. In accordance with Reference (a), I hereby report my being relieved of Command of the C.G. Loran Radio Station, Frederiksdal, Greenland, in compliance with References (b) and (c).
- 2. In company with my relief, I have conducted a thorough inspection of the base and exercised the crew at fire quarters.
- I consider that the personnel condition of this station is in general satisfactory, however the authorized complement should be increased by one MoMMlc because of the large amount of mechanical equipment installed and attached. The material condition of the station is satisfactory if due consideration is given to the fact that the station is at present being entirely rebuilt. A list of uncompleted repairs and authorized alterations has been shown to my relief and is on file. The record of public property has never been carried along properly and is in very poor condition. This is a result of the following circumstances: (1) The Transportation and supply set up is difficult and invoices are frequently not received with the supplies. (2) There has been no clerical help assigned this station. (3) Previous turnovers on relief were omitted because of the necessity for the relieved officer to depart immediately. A special and a permanent board of survey are being currently conducted by the Commanding Officer of the C.G.C. Evergreen on missing, broken, and worn out articles.

- 4. All registered publications have been inventoried in accordance with existing regulations and the transfer report has been forwarded to the Commandant. I have signed the log and all other records and papers requiring my signature. The following have been turned over to my relief:
  - (a) All unexcuted orders.
  - (b) All keys normally kept in the Captain's Cabin.
  - (c) There are no Honorable Discharge blanks, Honorable Discharge Buttons, Transportation Requests, or Tax Exemption Certificates on hand.
- 5. The itemized accounts of the following activities have been examined by my relief and their condition, on the dates indicated, was as follows:
  - (a) General Mess on 17 Feb., 1946, satisfactory.
  - (b) Ship's Service Store None.
  - (c) Welfare Fund None.
  - (d) Wardroom Mess None.
  - (e) Clothing Account None.
- 6. The following defects were noted: None other than those indicated above.


