1. Operational approval is granted for the installation of electronic equipment for communications at Loran Stations Wake, Eniwetok and Kwajalein as justified by reference (a). The following equipment is authorized each installation:

one (1) each FRT-23 transmitter
one (1) each high frequency receiver
three (3) each handy talkie portables

2. Operational clearance has been obtained for the following frequency usage at the Eniwetok, Kwajalein, and Wake Loran Stations:

3. Emergency use of CW frequencies authorized for Coast Guard use in the mid-pacific area may be made when required.

4. The United States Information Agency has requested that they be advised by the Commandant of activation of the frequency 9630 kc/s at these new locations. It is therefore requested that this office be advised accordingly.
