Subj : Photographs of Loran Stations in the Fourteenth District

1. It is understood that MASHBURN, E. F., PHC, will be aboard the KUKUI during the forthcoming repair and supply cruise to Fourteenth District loran stations. Photographs of loran station layout and details form a valuable part of records of loran operation, and are especially required as part of the Loran Station Operational Data Report.

2. It is requested that MASHBURN be instructed to obtain air and other photographs as will be of value to Headquarters records and which may be obtained dependent upon availability of plane and boats. Specific photographs desired are low level flight photographs showing complete station layout and detail photographs showing specific examples of corrosion, failure, and particularly good or bad practices (oil stowage, good painting, upkeep, etc.)

3. It is requested that Chief, Shore Units Division, by indorsement, list the specific loran stations in the Fourteenth District for which layout photographs are or are not desired.
