3. Aids to Navigation Division memorandum to Program Planning Division dated 21 September, 1950, requested an increase in allowance at Eniwetok by four (4) EE3 to man the monitor facility.
4. This Division considers that the allowances described in paragraphs 2 and 3, above, are adequate as pre-commissioning allowances and for the first few months of operation during which time the old Marshall's stations at Makin, Majuro and Kwadack (Kwajalein) will also be manned. During these first few months of operation of the new stations, practical conditions should dictate whether or not the temporary personnel allowances are satisfactory for establishment as permanent allowances.
