SUBJECT: Loran Training

1. It is requested that a U. S. Coast Guard Electronics Officer be placed on temporary duty with this command to conduct classroom and air instruction in the theory and use of loran airborne receiving equipment.

2. In the event that the above request is approved, the officer selected will report to the Commander, Pacific Division, MATS, Hickam Air Force Base, Honolulu, HI, on 14 January 1951, to begin instruction on the following day. It is recommended that the officer report to the MATS Passenger Handling Officer, Travis Air Force Base, Fairfield-Suisun, California on or about 13 January to arrange for air transportation via MATS aircraft to Hickam Air Force Base. Air priority CP-US-2D-0631-RM-1 has been designated for necessary air travel and should be stipulated in the written orders issued to the officer.
