- 1. In accordance with Article 2923, CG Regulations, the following report concerning inadequacy of quarters is submitted.
- 2. The present CO's quarters at this station is a room 8 x 9 feet, situated between the crew's sleeping quarters and the crew's head. There is a wash basin, but no bath or thilet facilities, the CO sharing the crew's head. These quarters afford no privacy and the location is not desirable for either the CO or thecrew. I attempted to live in these quarters but due to the cramped space, lack of privacy and noise caused by the crew, I moved out of the quarters last November and I have been living at a hotel in Bonzvista since that time at my own expense.
- 3. This matter was of no concern to previous COs as they all lived in town with their families. The house occupied by the two previous COs was not available to me, and it was the only house in the town with toilet facilities that had been available to rent. As this house was not available I could not move my family here.
- 4. I believe that this station is the only one in this area that has this condition, and that the other stations have a separate building for the CO's quarters. As these quarters do not meet the minimum requirements for quarters as prescribed by regulations, I believe that I should be entitled to reimbursement.
