DESCRIPTION (Use additional pages if necessary) TRANSFER LORAN-C MONITOR AT O'SHIMA TO COMFESSEC OFFICE, FUCHU, JAPAN - ASAP. 1. Monitor control of Loran-C rates SS3-X and SS3-Y from O'Shima has never been achieved. It is now apparent that an effective controlling monitor at O'Shima cannot be established without excessive and time consuming research. Tests indicate that Fuchu can control rate SS3-X and can usually control SS3-Y. 2. Equipment and personnel are presently available at O'Shima and are not being utilized effectively. A Loran-C monitor at Fuchu will not require support personnel.

JUSTIFICATION (Use additional pages if necessary) 1. As in paragraph 1 above. 2. Control of Loran-C rates SS3-X and SS3-Y will be improved at little initial cost. 3. Transfer of the Loran-C monitor will enable release of all property at O'Shima and disestablishment of the station when the Loran-A function is transferred to MSA Japan on 1 July 1966. This will result in a savings of approximately \$100,000.00 (all subheads). (See also CCGD14 OPP 5-65.)
