request for

- 1. This command is the separation point for Philippine nationals from the U. S. Coast Guard. In some cases personnel arrive without the necessary records to enable a timely separation. As no government quarters or messing facilities are available in the Manila area, these delays in separation become inordinately expensive to the government in payment of per diem.
- 2. It is requested that the Naval Station, Subic Bay, provide to this command, on a not to interfere basis, subsistence and quarters to Coast Guardsmen awaiting separation, on a non-reimbursable basis. The administrative processing of these separations would continue to be completed by this command.
- 3. The number of Coast Guardsmen arriving for separation is not expected to exceed ten a year.
