
1. You are hereby authorized to disestablish USCG Loran-C Monitor Station Bermuda (UK), during the First Quarter of Fiscal Year 1980 in consonance with termination of the existing U.S. East Coast Loran-C chain, rate 9930.
2. Unit OPFAC Number 05-40460 and Activity Address Code Z40460 are cancelled upon disestablishment. All references to this unit will be removed from the OPFAC. Direct the Commanding Officer to submit Form CG-4183, Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address, at least 30 days prior to disestablishment. Advise Commandant (G-WAN) by message of the effective date of disestablishment.
3. The personnel allowance for this unit will be cancelled. All billets will be reprogrammed within the Radionavigation Aids (RA) Program.
4. Dispose of any property which becomes excess as a result of this action in accordance with reference (a), the Comptroller Manual, CG-264 and the Real Property Manual, CG-262.
5. Destroy classified material locally in accordance with the Security Manual, CG-444.
6. This action will be accomplished with funds programmed by you for the scheduled closure. All OE funding for this unit will terminate on 1 January 1980. For the remainder of fiscal year 1980, OG-30, CG-4144, show a savings of \$27K.
7. Coordinate appropriate press releases concerning this action with Commandant (G-APA and G-AIA).
8. Commandant (G-AIA) will initiate appropriate notifications of the Governments of the United Kingdom and Bermuda.

Ref: (a) COMDT (G-WAN-2) ltr 16555.0/D5 of 9 APR 79, OFCO No. 30-79

1. As authorized by reference (a), disestablish USCG Loran-C Monitor Station Bermuda on or about 15 October 1979.
2. Unit OPFAC number 05-40460 and Activity Address Code Z40460 are cancelled upon disestablishment. Submit Form CG-4183, Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address, at least 30 days prior to disestablishment.
3. Advise CCGD5(dcs) by message of time and date disestablishment is effected. Make COMDT COGARD and COMLANTAREA COGARD information addressees.
4. Destroy classified material locally in accordance with the Security Manual (CG-444).
5. Until disestablishment, procure only items considered essential for the operation of the station, including those necessary for the safety, health and welfare of the crew. At least 30 days prior to disestablishment, cancel all outstanding purchase orders and requisitions. At time of disestablishment, forward SURF requisition log, SURF deck and completed purchase orders for FY80 to CCGD5(f).
6. Disestablishment will be accomplished utilizing unit funds. Upon disestablishment, release all unobligated funds to CCGD5(f) by message and mail a copy of first quarter FY80 target ledger to CCGD5(f).
7. Disposition instructions for all Loran-C, HF receiving equipment, electronics test equipment, miscellaneous electronics equipment, and other property required for Coast Guard or other DOT administrations will be forwarded by separate correspondence. Other property, including vehicles, will be transferred to the U.S. Naval Facility, Bermuda, for utilization or disposal. Forward copies of all transfer documents to CCGD5(flp).
8. Forward all Mutual Assistance records, reports and funds to CCGD5 (ps) prior to 30 September 1979. All outstanding loans are to be transferred to CCGD5 for collection.



9. All morale equipment in serviceable condition is to be transferred to Support Center Elizabeth City.
10. All Morale financial records are to be transferred to CCGD5 (ps) prior to 30 September 1979.
11. Instructions for termination of the imprest fund will be forwarded by separate correspondence.
12. Permanent change of station orders for all assigned personnel have been issued by separate correspondence.
13. The Commander, Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command has authorized the abandonment in place of station buildings, antennas, utility connections and appurtenant structures. Appropriate real property records will be forwarded to that command by CCGD5(flp).
14. Upon disestablishment, transfer custody of station buildings to Commanding Officer, U.S. Naval Facility, Bermuda.
15. Coordinate any press releases concerning disestablishment with CCGD5(dpa).
16. Commandant (G-AIA) is initiating appropriate notifications of the governments of the United Kingdom and Bermuda.
