Subj: COLRS, Port Aux Basques, Newfoundland; equipment for

1. Reference is made to your letter of 8 January, 1947, requesting copies of allowance lists for loran radio stations for purposes of refurbishing equipment to the Port Aux Basques station.

2. An allowance list specifically for the Port Aux Basques station is not available, nor is a list based on the needs of a typical station. The inclosed list, however, may be of some assistance to you in equipping Port Aux Basques. This list was originally prepared and used during the war in constructing and equipping the loran stations in the central and western Pacific areas, and consequently contains much outdated and superfluous information, and omits some items that may be needed at Port Aux Basques.

3. The ordnance allowance is in accordance with Coast Guard Ordnance Lists 4 and 5.

4. While it is expected that the equipment supplied Port Aux Basques will be more or less comparable to that presently supplied other stations under your command, it is considered that only such items as are required for proper operation and upkeep of the station and for the general welfare of the personnel attached need be supplied.
