1. Information on the history of LORSTA ADAK is practically non-existent at this unit. Records show that LTS, ADAK was probably the successor to LTS, AMCHITKA, the change being made sometime in 1952. Adak operated solely as a Loran A "double master" for rates LL6 and LL7 until 5 January, 1961, when the rates were changed to LL2 and LL3. In January 1961, this station became Service Area Monitor (SAM) for rate S6, in addition to being a Loran A station.
