- 1. Reference (b) stated that 11676 acres of government owned land with improvements thereon at the former U.S. Haval Air Facility, Attu, is tentatively access to the requirements of the 17th Haval District. It is being screened for resesignment or transfer prior to determination that it is excess to the meads of the Dept. of Defease.
  - 2. A portion of the land and facilities listed in reference (b) are presently occupied by the Coast Guard on permit from the Havy and constitute the reservation and most of the structures of Goast Guard Loren Station, Attu. The remainder of the station structures were erected by the Coast Guard.
  - 3. Inasmuch as the Loren Station is expected to operate on a continuing basis into the foreseeable future, Commendant is requested to arrange for the transfer from the Havy of the property as described below and as shown on the enclosed copies of COCD17 Drawing R-64, a parcel of land together with all improvements thereon and described as follows:

"Beginning at Signal Point at the intersection of mean high water and the Hast-West grid line described as N3000 in the Havy Grid System, preceed westerly along N3000 until it intersects the Herth-South grid line described as N8000. Proceed southerly along N8000 until it intersects the Rest-West grid line described as S5000. Proceed easterly along S5000 to the high water line in Gaseo Ray. Proceed easterly along the high water line slong Caseo Say, themse southerly around Caseo Point, and northerly along Massacre Bay to the point of beginning at Signal Point, also including Loaf Island in its entirety.

- 4. The area of land described above will give the Coest Guard execuship of the station buildings, both rumsays, and reservoir, all of which it new holds on permit and all of which are necessary for the proper operation of the station.
- 5. By copy haraof, Commonding Officer, Detachment 203 1155th Technical Operations Squadron, Elmondorf Air Force Base is advised of Coast Guard land requirements on Attu Island and is alorted to the possible additional Air Force requirements on Attu.
