The Station earned the Pacific Area 180-Day LORAN Award for outstanding performance on 17 December 1992. " unit maintained 99.996 percent usable signal for he 3-day period ending 5 October 1992 and a 99.99 percent sale signal for the 90-day period ending 4 January 1993. he Station achieved this performance despite operating on g nerator power and having the oldest 45-type transmitters still in operation, a harsh marine environment, and the rigors of isolated duty. In the effort to improve operational readine. , t.e unit developed and implemented an annual training plan or LORAN stations and improved watch qualifications. Despite a oply constraints, station personnel innovatively completed save al Civil Engineering Projects which significantly improve the habitability and operation of the Station and saved AR Coast Guard thousands of dollars.
