These included the installation of a new \_\_antitter secondary cooling system, radiator replacement on he main diesel generators, the completion of a \$500,00 contract to refinish the Station's fuel and water tar s, and liaison for a \$5 million Japanese Facilities provement Project to build replacement barracks facility.
