LORAN STATION MARCUS ISLAND - DISESTABLISHMENT AND TURNOVER TO JAPAN

TIME ZONE: ZULU plus 09 hours for all opentions.

1. SITUATION:

a. In accordance with refere ce (), LORAN-C Station (LORSTA) Marcus Island, Japan will disestablish and transfer LORAN-C operations to the Government of Japan on or about 01 October 1993.

b. A commemorative ce emony marking the Northwest Pacific (NWPAC) LORAN-C Chain to not ar to the Japanese Maritime Safety Agency (JMSA) will take proce at FESEC on 14 September 1993. A disestablishment cer mory sull be held on or about 01 October 1993 at LORSTA Marcus Is and.

c. This OP RDE. partains to the administrative disestablish on and turnover of station property and equipment to JMSA. LORAN coel from as the Whiskey secondary transmitting station for the NWPAC LORAN-C Chain (9970-W) shall continue uninterrupted with operational parameters maintained by JMSA.

f. <u>Detachments</u>: Upon completion of discribulishment procedures on or about 01 October 193 F. USCG personnel permanently assigned to the unit will depart for permanent change of station assignment. A small detach and of USCG personnel will remain at FESEC until 30 October 99, to handle matters related to the closure of all NWPAC LORS1. 5.

2. <u>Mission</u>: Prepare LORSTA Ma cus Island for turnover to JMSA and provide on-site training i JMSA personnel during the period 01 - 30 September 1993. Perform administrative and accounting duties in preparation for station disestablishment.

3. Execution: In a condarce with reference (a), LORSTA Marcus Island prepare the statich for turnover to JMSA, conduct on-site training for JMS. Frennel, and complete administrative disestablishmen: procedures no later than 01 October 1993 IAW reference (b)

(8) Submit call tel dining facility closing report. This report should inclue status of inventory, by item and amount, transferred/displaced of by survey, etc.

(9) 5 bm. t final report with survey for remaining inventory of full supply fund (85) to CCGD14(af).

(1) I. an Imprest Fund is involved, close out fund and return 1 h.⁴ to FESEC with final report.

(.1) Forward a list of historical artifacts to CO.T(G-CP) no later than 30 days prior to disestablishment. Int facts are the property of the U.S. Coast Guard and any una thorized transfer of artifacts is illegal. Artifacts must be thipped directly to the Coast Guard Exhibit Center, 7945 Fernham one, Forestville, MD 20747 unless otherwise authorized by COMDT(G-CP-3). Forward copies of transfer documents to CCGD14(af) via FESEC.

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(12) Inventory, package and ship any silver service Coast Guard Supply Center Baltimore marked for "Project 54A".

(13) Conduct an inventory of all general purpose (P) nd plant property to verify accuracy of current property listings. Provide equipment lists, as required by paragraph 5 of reference (a), separately listing equipment to be turned over to the Government of Japan and equipment to be returned to the Chast Guard. Provide required lists to FESEC for assemily into a combined report. Submit to CCGD14(af) via FESEC Per onal Property Accountability (PPA) Report along with Provide Survey (CG-5269) and signed DD-1348-1 forms for exclose or perty disposed of at DRMO.

(14) Ensure equipment (EEIS) and parts (ERPAL) items with "XB" cognizant are accurately and full (a counted for, including quantity and serial numbers. Provide Listing of these items to CCGD14(oan) for consolidation and for arising to COMDT(G-TEO) via MLCPAC(tes) which accurately reflects the inventory at the time of turnover to JMSA. Include, with the list, the number of line items and dollar value of ERPAL in ventory at the time of turnover.

(15) Ensure accur, by o. IRM inventory and transfer IRM equipment to USCG Base for ulu M/F CCGD14(dtis). Forward copies of DD-1149, citing equipment serial numbers, directly to CCGD14(dtis). Standard work stations (SWS) installed as standalone communication te finals integrated into the LORAN Timing and Control suiter will be left in place for use by JMSA. As such they must be inclue d with the equipment (EEIS) inventory as required by ar graph 3.a.(14) above.

(16) Di pose of any COMSEC material and equipment in accordance with instruction from TISCOM(ops) as per CMS-6. Follow structions contained in COMDTINST 2600.1 (series) to disectablish COMTAC accounts. Destroy all remaining classified materiah and forward all certificates of destruction to CCTD1 (dttm) in accordance with the CG Security Manual, COMDTINST M5. 0. 11

(17) Transfer government vehicles to JMSA. Provide ransfer document/DD-1149, clearly identifying vehicle by make/model and serial number, Part II of the CG-4327 Vehicle Acquisition and Disposition Report completely filled out,

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(17) (contd) including final odometer reading and sign and the old license/DOT tags to CCGD14(af), Attn: Mr. Erickson.

(18) Dispose of medications and controlled drugs in accordance with the CG Medical Manual, COMDTINST M6000.15, Chapter 10.

(19) Package correspondence files and station administrative records for retention IAW Paperwor' Mc. a rement Manual and send to FESEC for final disposition.

(20) Send LORAN operational records to FE EC for retention. Package separately according i qui ed storage duration as specified in COMDTINST M16500.1. 2004.1, table 2-4.

(21) Inventory and ship all Ra is quipment with a DD-1149 document to FESEC. Coordinate with FFSEC(ecv) to ensure accuracy of current allowance list P. pvide copies of DD-1149 documents for any Radiac equipment: listed on the allowance list previously turned in. FESEC will consolidate turn in of Radiac equipment account closure for al' NSEC units.

(22) Remove all U.S. 'oast Guard signs at the site. Ensure unit entrance sign .3 removed, destroyed, and disposed of properly.

b) Strus and disposition of all accounts: Commissary, Accountable forms, CMS, Morale funds, NMPS movies, operational records, ESO/Dantes account, Post Office account, exchange account and correspondence files.

. <u>dministration</u>, Communications, and Logistics:

a. Administration:

(1) CCGD14(af) will submit form CG-4183, Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address allowing as much lead time

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(1) (contd) as possible, but at least 30 days in ad anc , before disestablishment of LORSTA Marcus Island. CCGD14(af) (i) submit a second CG-4183 to CG Supply Center Baltimore for the Navy "N" service Unit Identification Code (UIC) for LORST. M. rcus Island.

(2) IRT paragraph 8.a. of reference (a), CCGD14(a) will contact Systems Development (SD) and General Accounting (OG) branches at FINCEN to close out Marcus Island's accounting records and will provide FINCEN with a list of progression elements to be cancelled.

(3) FESEC will initiate correspondence of terminate Airlift Mobility Command (AMC) frequency the new requirement.

(4) FESEC will store all NWPA, LORAL C operational records and dispose of them IAW curre. guidelines.

(5) LORSTA Marcus Islan, il. notify local vendor, in writing, to close out fuel accont. Ensure JMSA Prospective Commanding Officer LORSTA Marcus 'sland has coordinated similar efforts to continue service under JMSA billing. Funding and MIPR support for fuel will be derinated by FESEC and CCGD14(af).

b. Communications

(1) The existing communication systems and network will remain in place for use by JMSA. FESEC will provide liaison to USFJ as needed there use DOD-support systems continue in operation JAW effectnce (d).

(2) C.GD.+(dttm) will submit necessary correspondence to delete call sig. "NRV6" from applicable publications and delete frequency play Pl4.01 from reference (c). Annex Kilo to the Dl4 SOP should be revised to delete all references to LORSTA Marcus Islan. Correspondence will emphasize that listed frequencies are under the control of the U.S. Forces Japan frequency curcinator and will be retained by USFJ for further use by JMSA in acordance with reference (d).

(3) CCGD14(dttm) will take necessary action to cancel eneral message distribution to FESEC and FESEC units and discontinue AIG EIGHT NINE SIX ZERO effective 15 October 1993.

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(4) COCO NWPAC Chain will transmit AIG message 30 days in advance and at the time of occurrence, announcing the date time group for JMSA assumption of 9970 WHISKEY LORAN-C operations t LORAN-C users.

c. Logistics: Logistics to/from Marcus Island will be provided by USAF AMC aircraft. JMSA personnel will be transported via GOJ aircraft. Station vehicles will be transferred and re-registered to JMSA when no lon, er and ed by USCG.

d. <u>Liaison with JMSA</u>: CO, LORSTA Marcus Isl na is authorized direct liaison with the senior 'MS of icer present during the training period. COMFESEC will rouse liaison with the appropriate regional JMSA HQ.

5. <u>Coordinating Instructions</u>:

a. This OPORDER is effective upon receipt for planning purposes and for execution according to the timetable established by the planning proposal.

b. CCGD14(oan) is the overall coordinator and point of contact for this OPORDER. Commander, Far East Section is the designated project office for all NWPAC LORAN station turnover activities. Therefore for ESEC will provide all direction and coordination of activities affecting this OPORDER.
