Dear Sir:

Enclosed herswith is a sketch plan showing your pipeline to Upolu from our water system at Kokoiki, Kohala, Hawaii.

We are apprised that in running this line down to Upolu there are quite a few airpockets. We propose to install a tank at Sta.25+27.31 to eliminate one of the humpa. The installation of this tank will permit us to serve some other tenants of the Bishop Estate makai. In order to accomplish this, we must have you dedicate the line from Sta. O to Sta. 25-27.31 to the Board of Water Supply. This would mean that we shall operate and maintain it as if it were our own property and we will be responsible for all the costs. It is understood that the easement which has been obtained (to the tank) will be transferred to us.

Since I will be in Honolulu on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of this week. I would like to discuss this matter with you and a representative of the Bishop Estate. I will contact you and the Bishop Estate upon my arrival in Honolulu as to an appointment relative therefor.



PERMANENT FILE

STATION WATER SUPPLY

The Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard (PERMITTOR), hereby grants KAHUA RANCH, Limited (PERMITTEE) a permit for a term of five years, but revocable at will, to install, maintain, repair and use a water line for watering livestock, at U. S. Coast Guard Loran Station, Upolu Point, Hawaii, as indicated in red on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This PERMIT is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That said installation, maintenance, repair and use shall be without cost to the U. S. Coast Guard, under the general supervision of the officer having immediate jurisdiction over the premises authorized to be used.
- 2. That the PERMITTEE shall at its own expense, and without cost or expense to the U. S. Coast Guard, install a meter and shut off valve within three (3) feet of the connection to the U. S. Coast Guard water main. PERMITTEE's service line shall be of minimum size consistent with its requirements and in no event shall exceed 1 1/2" in diameter. Frior to connecting its line PERMITTEE shall furnish the U. S. Coast Guard with a written agreement from Hawaii County Board of Water Supply that gallonage drawn through PERMITTEE's meter will be subtracted from the gross U. S. Coast Guard reading and billed to the PERMITTEE. PERMITTEE shall obtain all necessary permits and consents for this installation and shall comply with all applicable legal requirements.
- 3. That any interference with or damage to property under the control of the U. S. Coast Guard incident to the exercise of the privileges herein granted shall be promptly corrected by the PERMITTEE to the satisfaction of the officer having immediate jurisdiction over the premises.
- 4. That no additions to or alterations of the premises shall be made without the prior consent of the officer having immediate jurisdiction over the premises, except as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That if for any reason it should be deemed necessary or expedient for the U. S. Coast Guard to perform functions and/or render services which are the responsibility of the PERMITTEE, the PERMITTEE shall reimburse the U. S. Coast Guard therefor.
- 6. That on or before the date of expiration of this permit or its relinquishment by the PERMITTEE, the PERMITTEE shall vacate the said premises, remove its property therefrom, and restore the premises to a condition satisfactory to the officer exercising immediate jurisdiction over the premises, ordinary wear and tear and damage beyond the control of the PERMITTEE excepted. If, however, this permit is revoked, the PERMITTEE shall vacate the premises, remove its property therefrom, and restore the premises as aforesaid within such time as the PERMITTOR may designate.

- 7. It is understood that the U. S. Coast Guard accepts no responsibility for the quality or quantity of water available under this permit. It is further understood that the U. S. Coast Guard shall not be required to make any change in its maintenance standards for its water main and may at any time discontinue, abandon, reroute or otherwise modify its water main without liability to PERMITTEE.
- 8. In the event that death or injury occurs to any person, or loss, destruction or damage occurs to any property of the PERMITTEE, its agents or employees, or any third person in connection with the installation, maintenance, repair or use of the aforesaid water line, occasioned in whole or in part by the acts or omission of the PERMITTEE, the PERMITTEE shall assume all liability therefor and will immediately indemnify and save harmless the U. S. Coast Guard, its officers, agents or employees from any liability arising as aforesaid.
- 9. The officer exercising immediate jurisdiction over the premises is Commander, 14th Coast Guard District, P. O. Box 4010, Honolulu, Hawaii.
- 10. Subject to U. S. Coast Guard requirements this permit may be extended for additional five year periods upon written request by the PERMITTEE to the officer exercising immediate jurisdiction over the premises 30 days prior to the expiration of this permit or any renewal thereof.



Dear Sir:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated December 10, 1963, N26, Serial 103-64, regarding ingress and egress over the United States Coast Guard road in the vicinity of the USCG Loran Transmitting Station at Upolu, North Kohala.

We appreciate your granting the Board of Water Supply permission to read the recently-installed meter, which installation was to accommodate Kahua Ranch.

For your information, in accordance with the permit granted Kahua Ranch, Permit No. 14-PE-3-62, by Admiral A. C. Richmond, USCG, a new metered connection has been provided for Kahua Ranch from the U.S. Coast Guard pipeline. In order to properly record the division of water for the Kahua Ranch at this new meter installation, a new separate 1-1/2" meter has been installed to record the Coast Guard water consumption. The original meter installed at the beginning of the Coast Guard pipeline at Kokoiki has been left in place to serve as a master meter to record the total flow. The new meter will record only that portion of the water consumed by the Coast Guard Station. This is to provide accurate records and to facilitate our billing for water charges.

The above installation was done at the request of and at the expense of Kahua Ranch. It is understood by the Board of Water Supply that the Coast Guard pipeline is still the property of the Coast Guard and that the metered installation for Kahua Ranch is only for the convenience of said Ranch. It is further understood that Kahua Ranch will be responsible for this installation in accordance with the permit granted to it by the U.S.Coast Guard.

May we express our appreciation for the splendid cooperation we have received in taking care of the needs of one of our customers.

Dear CWO-4 Rebkovich:

I am the owner of 1.3 acres located just above the Coast Guard Station, TMk 3-5-6-1-45.

I would like to ask permission to tap into the Coast Guard water line with the understanding that I will be responsible for installing a meter, paying any costs incurred to the County Water Dept., and based on the same rate charged by the County Water Dept., I will pay to the Coast Guard the cost for the water that I use either monthly or every two months.

Enclosed is a copy of my current water bill. Normally, for one house with five occupants, I use 21,000 gallons over a two month period. Since my property is zoned AG-20, which allows for one house and an Ohana dwelling, I will estimate that the most water that would be consumed would be 42,000 gallons over a two month period.
